Sub:- Permission under Section 6(1A) of the Foreign  
Contribution (Regulation) Act, 1976 for acceptance  
of foreign contribution by the : Institute of Health  
Systems, Hyderabad.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No. Nil dated 4.2.91 on the subject noted above and to say that the Central Govt. have accorded permission under section 6(1A) of the Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act, 1976 to the Institute of Health Systems, DMS Complex, Sultan Bazaar, Hyderabad for acceptance of foreign contribution from the Ford foundations, New Delhi amounting to US \$40,000/- (forty thousand US dollars only)

2. The Organisation should :-

- 1) - send an intimation to the Central Government as to the amount of foreign contribution received by it, the source from which and the manner in which such foreign contribution was received and the purpose for which and the manner in which such contribution was utilised, for every half year beginning on the 1st day of January and the 1st day of July every year, in form FC-3 in duplicate within thirty days of the closure of the half year;
- ii) Maintain a separate set of accounts and records exclusively for foreign contribution received and utilised.
- a) in the form FC-6, where the foreign contribution relates only to articles as referred to item (i) of the clause (c) of the sub-section (1) of the section 2 of the Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act, 1976;

- (b) in the Cash book and ledger account in double entry basis, where the foreign contribution relates to currency received and utilised and a separate Bank account be maintained in respect of such contribution;
- (c) in Form FC-7, where the foreign contribution relates to Foreign securities;
- iii) maintain a record as to the manner in which such foreign contribution has been utilised by it;
- iv) Maintain every account specified above on an yearly basis, commencing on the 1st day of January each year and every such account, duly certified by a Chartered accountant in Form FC-9 should be furnished, in duplicate to the Secretary to the Government of India, in the Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi, within sixty days of the closure of the Calender year.


Dear Mr. Sudarshan,


