Subject :- Permission under Section 6(1a) of the Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act, 1976 for acceptance of foreign contribution by Institute of Health Systems, Hyderabad, AP.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No. IHS/FCRA/10/93 dated 16.11.93 on the subject noted above and to say that the Central Government have accorded permission under Section-6(1A) of the Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act, 1976 to the Institute of Health Systems, DHS Complex, Sultan Bazaar, Hyderabad-500 195, A.P. for acceptance of foreign contribution amounting to \$2,867/- (Two thousand eight hundred and sixty seven US dollars only) from Department of Health & Human Services, National Institute of Health, National Heart Lung & Blood Institute, Bethesda, Maryland, USA.


2. The organisation should:-

- 1) send an intimation to the Central Government addressed to the Secretary to the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, FCRA Division, Lok Nayak Bhavan, New Delhi-110 003, on an yearly basis in the prescribed form FC-3 revised with effect from 1.4.91 (in duplicate) beginning on the 1st day of April every year and ending on 31st day of March of the next calendar year as to the amount of foreign contribution received by it, the source from which and the manner in which such foreign contribution was received and the manner in which such foreign contribution was utilised, within sixty days of the closure of the year, with a certificate of Chartered Accountant in the prescribed form annexed therewith.

- ii) Maintain a separate set of accounts and records exclusively for foreign contribution received and utilised:-
- a) in the form FC-5 where the foreign contribution relates only to articles as referred to item (a) of the clause (c) of Sub-~~XXXXXX~~ Section (1) of the Section 2 of the Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act, 1976.
 - b) in the cash book and ledger accounts in double entry basis, where the foreign contribution relates to the currency received and utilised and a separate Bank account be maintained in respect of such contribution.
 - c) in form FC-7 where the foreign contribution relates to foreign securities.
- iii) maintain record as to the manner in which such foreign contribution has been utilised by it.
- iv) maintain every account specified above on an yearly basis commencing on the 1st day of April each year.
